April saw the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 come into force. This has seen yet more costs added to builds with more compliancing and safety equipment required.

All access (including trades, subbies & clients) to construction sites must now be controlled and recorded. In order to meet our obligations we have teamed up with Safety Mate. SafetyMate is proudly designed and built in New Zealand for all business.

Prior to accessing your construction site you will now need to be inducted into the Safety Mate system by an Epic Team member, sign to say you have been inducted and understand your responsibilities whilst on site. You will be allocated a log in to use with the app on your smart phone or tablet. Every construction site will have its own unique QR code which you scan using the SafetyMate app on your phone. This will log you as being present on the site. When you leave the site you logout
